EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The year 2016 marked the beginning of implementation of the new HIV & AIDS National Strategic Plan 2016-2020 and Health Sector HIV Strategic Framework 2016-2020.

In 2016, HIV prevalence amongst pregnant women attending Antenatal Care was 2.4% as against that of 1.8% in 2015 and 1.6% in 2014 (2016 HIV Sentinel Survey Report, April 2017).

More persons living in Ghana got to know their HIV status in 2016 compared to 2015; a total of One Million and Forty Thousand, Four Hundred and Thirty (1,040,430) out of a target of two million, five hundred and seventy-six thousand, and fifty-five persons (2,576,055) were tested for HIV; giving a 40% coverage. Approximately 15% were males (153,958), 18% (184,091) were non-pregnant females and the remaining 67% (702,381) were pregnant women.

Two thousand seven hundred and forty-eight (2,748) sites were providing PMTCT services by the end of 2016 compared to 2,325 in 2015. The number of pregnant women tested and counselled for HIV and who received their results was seven hundred and two thousand, three hundred and eighty-one (702,381); 18,116 (2.8%) were positive and 9,680 (53% of positives) were provided ARVs to Prevent Mother-To-Child Transmission of HIV (PMTCT). The number of pregnant women who got to know their HIV sero-status represents 77% coverage of the annual Global Fund Performance Framework target of 914,357

and 62% of the year's 1,132,332 expected pregnancies.

In the course of the year, the Programme organised HIV Testing and Counselling, PMTCT and EID training Programmes in service delivery areas for health workers from all the regions. There were trainings for Health Care Workers in Pharmacovigilance and the ART Treat All strategy in Ashanti, Eastern, Greater Accra and Western regions.

Five thousand, five hundred and fifty-one (**5,551**) HIV exposed infants received Early Infant Diagnosis (EID), 12% of whom were positive (693). This represents a 49% increase over the previous year but still only 45% of the National HIV and AIDS Strategic Plan (2016-2020) and 25% of the Health Sector HIV M&E Plan (2016-2020) annual targets respectively.

Twenty thousand, four hundred and ninety-seven (**20,497**) adults and children were initiated on ART in 2016, (5,568 males and 14,929 females) in 245 sites. The target for the year was Nineteen thousand, four hundred and twenty-three (**19,423**). However the number initiated is only 36% (**57,709**) of all persons identified as HIV positive in the year under review.

The estimated 2016 HIV population in Ghana is 290,000 (EPP Spectrum Estimates 2016). With 100,665 PLHIV on ART as at end of December 2016, the estimated population of ART coverage is therefore 35%. More PLHIV must therefore

be enrolled into ART care through the 'treat all' strategy in line with the 90/90/90 targets to bridge the annual gap in ART need.

The TB/HIV Collaboration continued and in 2016, the number of PLHIV who were screened for TB symptoms was seventy-four thousand, two hundred and twenty-six (74,226) as against that of sixty-three thousand, eight hundred and twenty-six (63,826) in 2015. There were one thousand, two hundred and forty-seven (1,247) HIV Positive TB Clients on ART. Health care workers from Fifty DOTS corners were trained after assessment in 2015 to offer ART in Ashanti, Eastern, Greater Accra and Western Regions.

Under the Cooperative Agreement between the Ghana Health Service and United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Proficiency Testing (PT), Basic Laboratory Information System (BLIS) Programmes and the Site Improvement Monitoring System (SIMS) visits were continued in 2016. Eight out of nine PCR machines participated in two rounds of proficiency testing programme in HIV Viral Load (VL) and Early Infant Diagnosis (EID) organised by AfriQuaLabin Senegal and CDC, Atlanta. Dried Tube Specimen Proficiency Testing (DTSPT) for HIV serology initially piloted in Greater Accra and Eastern region were expanded to cover, Western, Ashanti, All HSS sites and selected FHI 360 facilities. Results for Rounds two and three among the regions showed an increase from 74% to 85% proficiency testing. The BLIS supervisory visits were complemented with a needs assessment of all PCR sites. BLIS was adapted as a tool for VL and EID data management to feed information into DHIMS 2 and E-tracker.

The Site Improvement Monitoring System (SIMS) visits were undertaken to selected HIV rapid testing sites within the Greater Accra, Eastern, Western and Ashanti regions. Overall, there were general improvements of sites after initial visits.

In the year under review the Programme received a total funding support of \$24,637,099.08 from its donor partners. The Global Fund provided 97% of the total funds whilst other donors (CDC, APHL, WHO and the UNICEF) contributed \$639,936.90 representing 3% of total receipts. These Funds supported the GHS/MoH in the implementation of strategic activities such as HTS, PMTCT, ART, HIV/TB Collaboration, Health Systems Strengthening, Programme Management and M&E. The year's total expenditure was \$29,521,836.94. Significantly the process for securing additional funds from the CDC/PEPFAR and the Global Fund started in the year under review. The Government of Ghana signed an MOU with PEPFAR to support the take-off of the 'Treat All' programme with ARVs and laboratory commodities to the tune of \$23.7million for 2017 and 2018. The Global Fund also announced a new fund allocation of approximately \$194million for AIDS, TB and Malaria for the period 2018-2020.

The programme is appreciative of all the support from the, DG-GHS, Director PHD, MOH, GAC, Development Partners, other GHS Divisions, Government & Non-governmental stakeholders, Service Providers and the Association of PLHIV.



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INTRODUCTION

The National AIDS/STI Control Programme (NACP) is a Division under the Disease Control and Prevention Department of the Public Health Division of the Ghana Health Service (GHS). NACP is mandated to coordinate and implement HIV and AIDS related activities of the Ghana Health Sector Strategic Framework.

Brief Implementation Context/Framework

The National AIDS/STI Control Programme started as a National Technical Committee on AIDS, later became National Advisory Council on HIV and AIDS in 1985 and National AIDS/STI Control Programme (NACP) in 1987. NACP has since been the lead agency in the health sector's response to HIV and AIDS in Ghana.

The NACP/GHS is responsible for implementing the health sector aspects of the National HIV and AIDS Strategic Plan (NSP 2016-2020). Additionally programme interventions are guided by the Health Sector Programme of Work and the current Health Sector HIV Strategic Framework (2016-2020).

The National AIDS/STI Control Programme is mandated to carry out the following activities:

- The delivery of a package of interventions to reduce HIV transmission.
- The provision of care and support services for Persons Living with HIV (PLHIV).
- The delivery of Strategic Information on HIV and AIDS and other STIs.
- The provision of essential technical support to all Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) in the implementation of their HIV programmes.

The 2016 Annual Report provides a narration of key activities undertaken in the year under the following broad performance areas.

- HIV Testing Services (Including Behaviour Change Communication, Condom promotion and Information, Education and Communication).
- Elimination of Mother-To-Child Transmission (EMTCT) services.
- Antiretroviral Therapy.
- Sexually Transmitted Infections Management.
- Opportunistic Infections Management.
- Blood safety and Laboratory Quality Assurance.

It also captures activities undertaken under the Cooperative Agreement (COAG) between the GHS/NACP and CDC. Financial inflows and expenditure within the year are highlighted in addition to status of staff and service delivery sites.

THE PACKAGE OF INTERVENTIONS TO REDUCE HIV TRANSMISSION

Various interventions were undertaken to prevent the spread of new infections in 2016 as follows:

- HIV Testing and Counselling Services.
- Elimination of Mother-To-Child Transmission of HIV.
- Sexually Transmitted Infection Management.
- Condom Promotion and Distribution.
- Blood Safety.
- Advocacy, Communication and Social Mobilization for Demand Creation.

2.1

HIV Testing and Counselling

In 2016 the Programme routinely offered HIV Testing Services (HTS) to persons who wanted to know their status and also learn more about HIV and AIDS in order to make informed decisions about their sexual and reproductive health. HTC serves as the entry point to anti-retroviral treatment, and helps to prevent new infections and/or re-infection in the general population.

One Million and Forty Thousand, Four Hundred and Thirty (1,040,430) out of a target of two million, five hundred and seventy six thousand, and fifty-five persons (2,576,055) were tested for HIV in 2016, thus 40% of the expected HTC services target for the year. The HIV prevalence among the HTC clients was 5.5% as compared to 4.8% in 2015 and 6% for 2014. Table 2.1 shows number of persons tested and counselled for HIV in 2016, whilst table 2.2 shows regional coverage. Table 2.3 shows the trend of persons tested and counselled from 2014 to 2016.

Fig. 2.1 MAP OF HIV COVERAGE FOR TESTING AND COUNSELING FOR 2016

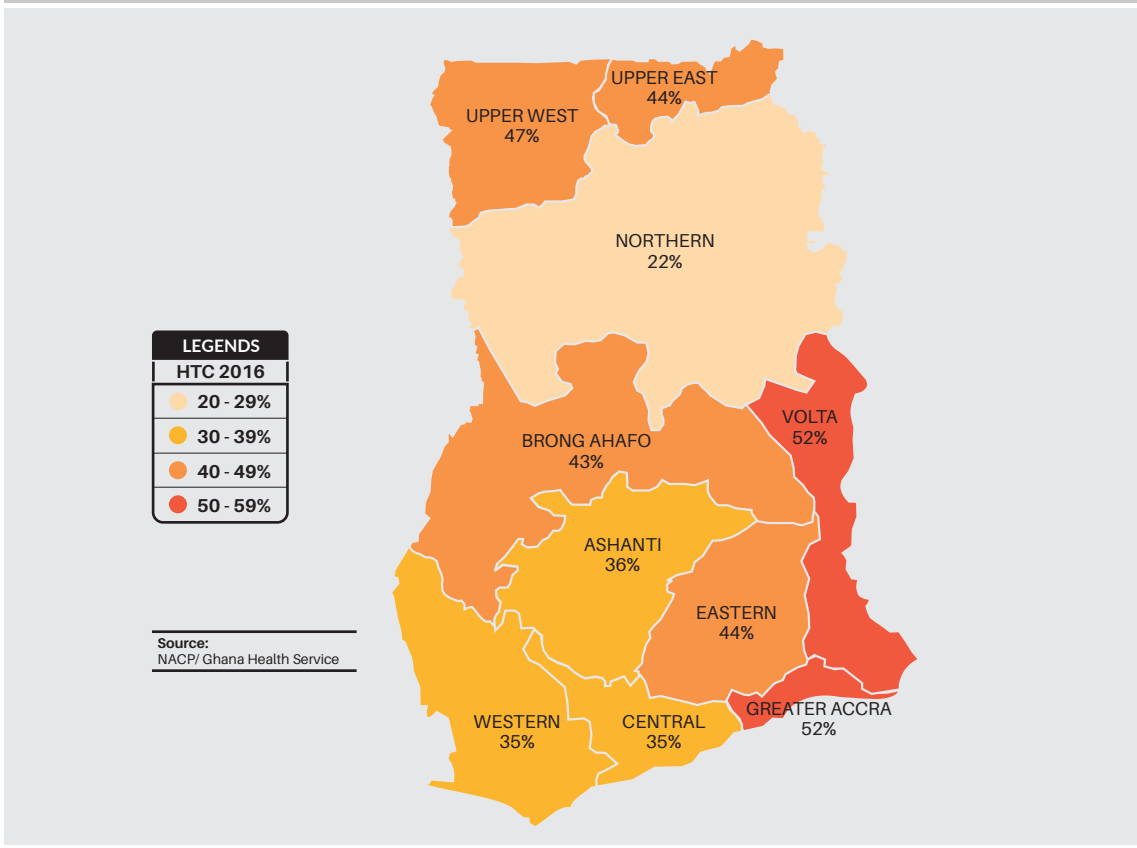

Prevention of Mother-To-Child Transmission (PMTCT)

In 2016, two thousand seven hundred and forty-eight (2,748) health facilities provided PMTCT of HIV services. Provision of PMTCT services has many sides and Ghana's approach to providing the package of interventions is to reduce the risk of MTCT of HIV till the elimination target of less than 5% transmission rate is achieved. The various activities undertaken in the year 2016 under the four prongs were as follows:

2.2.1 Prong One: Primary Prevention

All Service delivery points encouraged pregnant women to know their HIV status in order to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus, from mother to baby. This key component of Prevention of Mother-To-Child Transmission service delivery acts as the entry point of ART care for mothers. HIV testing and counselling services were provided at all PMTCT Centres.

In 2016, 702,381 pregnant women out of 1,132,332 targetted expected pregnancies got to know their HIV sero-status. This represents 77% coverage of the annual Global Fund Performance Framework target of 914,357 and 62% of the 2016 target in M&E Plan 2016-2020. Post-test and continuous counselling was offered to all clients to highlight the need to avoid HIV infection amongst those who tested negative or re-infection amongst those who tested positive.

According to Ghana's protocol, all those who tested negative were retested at 34 weeks. This is to ensure those who had become infected after the initial testing were all identified and taken care of.

The proportions of pregnant women who were tested HIV positive in the regions is depicted in table 2.4. In 2016, Eighteen thousand, one hundred and sixteen (18,116) were found to be HIV positive (2.6%) following testing. Eight Thousand five hundred and seventeen (8,517) pregnant women were found to be HIV positive during retesting at 34 weeks (1.2%).

Fig. 2.2 MAP OF PERCENTAGE OF PREGNANT WOMEN WHO TESTED POSITIVE IN 2016

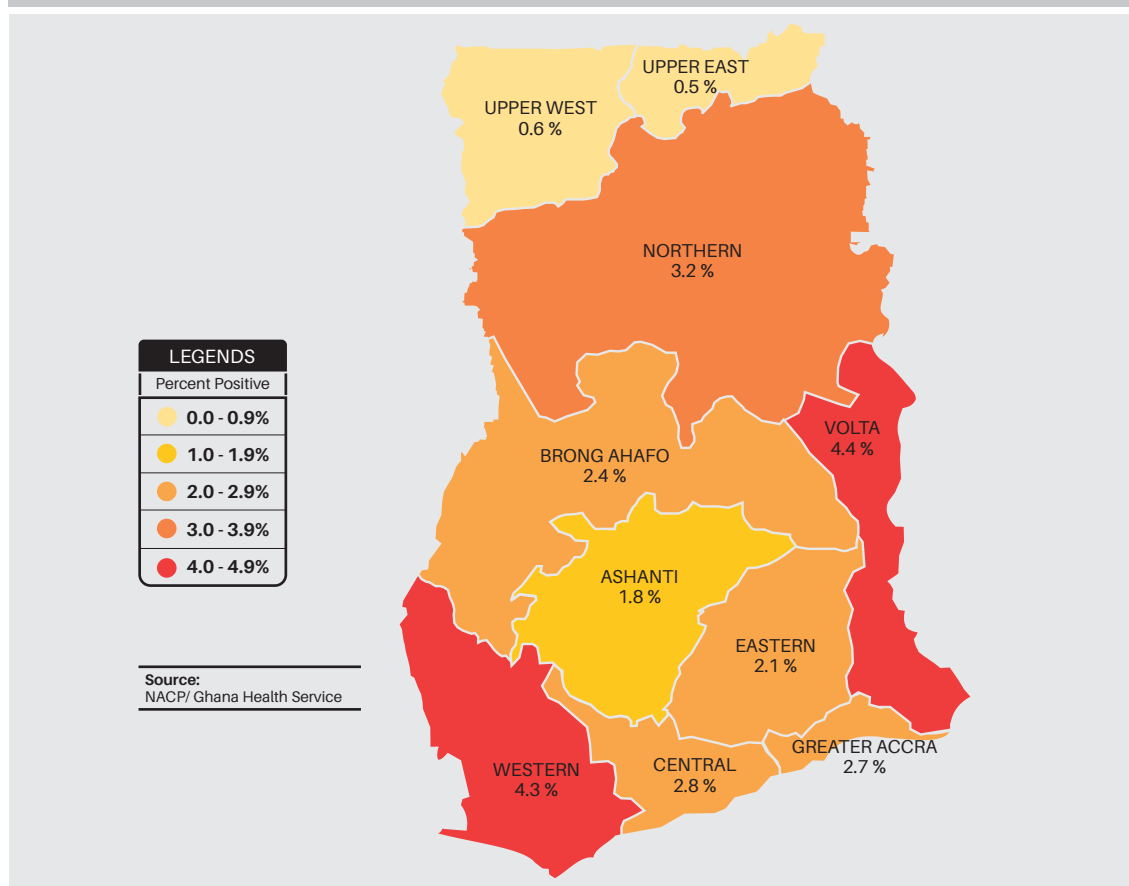

2.2.2 Prong Two: Preventing Unintended Pregnancies

The NACP liaised with Family Health Division of the Ghana Health Service, and provided Family planning (FP) services as part of ANC at all service delivery points. Women seeking PMTCT services also got Family Planning services and were catered for or linked to services where necessary during the ante-natal and post-natal periods. HIV positive non-pregnant women were also referred for Family Planning services. Service providers offered condoms to HIV positive and negative clients during the year. NACP distributed, through the Family Health Division of the Ghana Health Service, with the support of MoH, USAID and UNFPA, a total of 28,101,985 pieces of male condoms. The Family Health Division has detailed data on provision of Family Planning from the Reproductive and Child Health Unit (RCH) of the Ghana Health Service.

2.2.3 Prong Three: Provision of PMTCT Interventions

Ghana adopted the policy of using combination anti-retroviral therapy for PMTCT in 2006 and updated its protocol in 2010 to triple ARVs for HIV positive pregnant women to further reduce Mother-to-Child Transmission (MTCT) rates.

Nine thousand, six hundred and eighty (9,680) positive pregnant women (53%) received ARVs as treatment in 2016.

The above table shows that more pregnant women were tested for HIV in 2016 compared to 2015. The number of positive women also increased, but the relative proportion of positive women who were provided with triple ARVs dropped.

2.2.4 Prong Four: Provision of Treatment, Care and Support Services for Mothers, their Infants and Families

Treatment, Care and Support Services remained an intergral part of the package of interventions aimed at the mothers, their infants and families through the right linkages to services. Male involvement in PMTCT through couple counselling and partner testing in some facilities were very useful. Gradually the intervention would be replicated in all service delivery points to enhance uptake of PMTCT at the community level.

Appropriate services such as post-natal, family planning, nutrition and child welfare services were given to mothers and their infants at the ART centers for continued care. They were also followed up for Early Diagnosis of HIV.

The regional distribution is as shown in table 2.7 and confirms gaps in all regions. As shown in Table 2.7, Upper East Region had the highest coverage of facilities providing PMTCT services (97%) and the Central region has the lowest (48%). The average national coverage of PMTCT services is 73%, an increase of 11% over the previous year.

2.2.5 Syphilis

Syphilis Testing improved extremely and more pregnant positive mothers were given treatment with Benzathine Penicillin.

Syphilis test kits were provided free to all health facilities providing PMTCT services to ensure all pregnant women were tested at the same time that they received HIV testing. This was to eliminate the barriers to screening when conducted in the laboratory. In spite of that, fewer women were tested for syphilis than HIV however there is a general improvement over the previous year. In the year under review, 603,465 pregnant women were tested for syphilis and 100 % of those found positive were treated together with their partners.

A significant 98,916 pregnant women who received HIV testing missed syphilis testing. NACP aims at ensuring HIV Testing and Syphilis are at par and clients receive 100% treatment for persons who test positive for Syphilis.

2.2.6 Capacity Building for E-MTCT

One major challenge at the beginning of the year was the lack of human resource capacity at all levels of the health care system to provide PMTCT/EID and related HIV services. In lieu of this, the United Nations Children Fund (UNICEF) collaborated with the programme to organize HTS/PMTCT workshop for One hundred and seventy six (176) Health care providers in three regions as part of activities to achieve Ghana’s goal of virtually eliminating Mother-to-Child-Transmission (MTCT) of HIV. The objectives were to provide trainee counselors with adequate knowledge in HTS/PMTCT to enable them provide comprehensive PMTCT Services in different settings, discuss infant feeding in the context of HIV infection and to equip them with skills in HIV antibodies testing and sample taking for EID.

In total, the Programme had fresh/refresher trainings for One thousand, one hundred and eighty three (1,183) health workers from the entire country in the Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission of HIV. This is all geared towards EMTCT.

2.2.7 Early Infant Diagnosis of HIV

A total of 5,551 exposed babies were screened for HIV in various facilities as shown in table 2.9 below:

In 2016 5,551 of HIV Exposed Infants were screened for HIV as compared to 3,733 in 2015. Overall, 12% of the exposed babies in 2016 were found to be HIV positive compared to 9% in 2015.

2.3 Blood Safety

The risk of HIV transfusion through infected blood products exceeds that of any other risk exposure. Therefore the programme provided all health institutions with test kits for HIV screening to ensure that all blood and blood products for transfusion are screened for HIV antibodies among other tests. This is clearly in line with Ghana's national policy of elimination of blood transmissible HIV infection.

A total of **201,765** units of blood were screened for HIV throughout the country and **7,314** were found to be HIV reactive, a prevalence of **3.6%**. The regional distribution is as shown in table 2.10 below.

2.4 HIV Exposure Prevention in Health Care and other Settings

In all training workshops and seminars, Universal infection prevention measures were emphasized. During monitoring and supervisory visits that the Programme organized, health care providers were constantly reminded of precautionary measures as a means of reducing exposure to HIV. Also, health facilities were encouraged to display the protocols and contact numbers of persons capable of administering Post Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP), at visible places for ease of reference.

In 2016, a total of 1,153 persons received Post Exposure Prophylaxis with 18% being Rape Survivors, whilst the rest were due to occupational exposures and five people turned out to be HIV positive out of the exposure.

THE DELIVERY OF THE PACKAGE OF CARE AND SUPPORT SERVICES FOR PLHIV

Care and Support services are geared towards providing package of interventions to improve the quality of health and elongate the life of PLHIV. NACP continued with the provision of ART services to enhance the quality of life of the PLHIV.

Interventions included:

- Prevention and Management of Opportunistic Infections (OIs).
- Anti-Retroviral Therapy.
- Continuous Supportive Counselling.
- Effective Home Based Care.
- Working with PLHIV and their Associations.
- Greater Involvement of Persons Living with HIV and AIDS (GIPA).

3.1

Management of Opportunistic Infections

Opportunistic Infections occur when the immune system is compromised. It is important to treat Opportunistic Infections before initiating a client on ART. Clients already on ART must also be treated for any OIs, however prescribers must be mindful of drug-drug interactions.

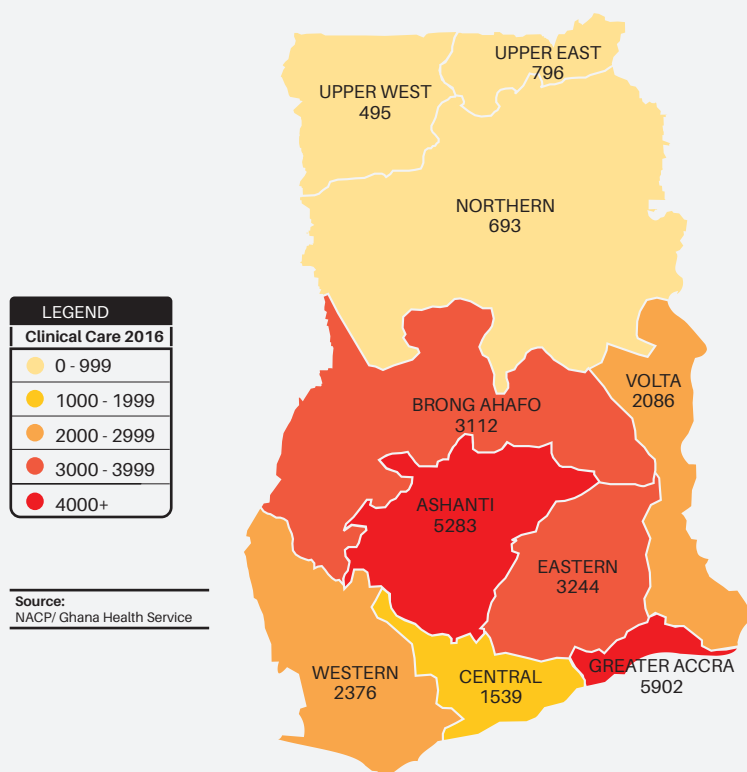
To prevent OIs in PLHIV, a total of 19,156 Persons were given OI medications (Co-trimoxazole prophylaxis) in 2016 compared to 17,523 in 2015. The breakdown is: 17,576 adults (5,311 males and 12,265 females) and 1,580 children (768 boys and 812 girls).

Twenty five thousand five hundred and twenty six clients were newly enrolled into care because they were confirmed HIV positive through testing. However not all of them were enrolled onto ART due to CD4 and WHO criteria. It is expected that by the time the ‘treat all’ policy is fully operationalised in all ten regions, every single client enrolled in clinical care will immediately be initiated on ART.

3.2 Anti Retroviral Therapy

Providing Anti-Retrovirals (ARVs) to Persons Living with HIV and AIDS (PLHIV) remained mandatory so as to reduce morbidity and mortality among the infected and to prolong life. Presently, Two hundred and forty five (245) health facilities are providing ART services throughout the country.

In 2016, a total of 20,497 persons were newly enrolled on treatment (19,107 adults and 1,390 children) i.e. 80% of the number enrolled into clinical care. Within the same year also 2,106 persons were reported to have died, stopped treatment or lost to follow-up.

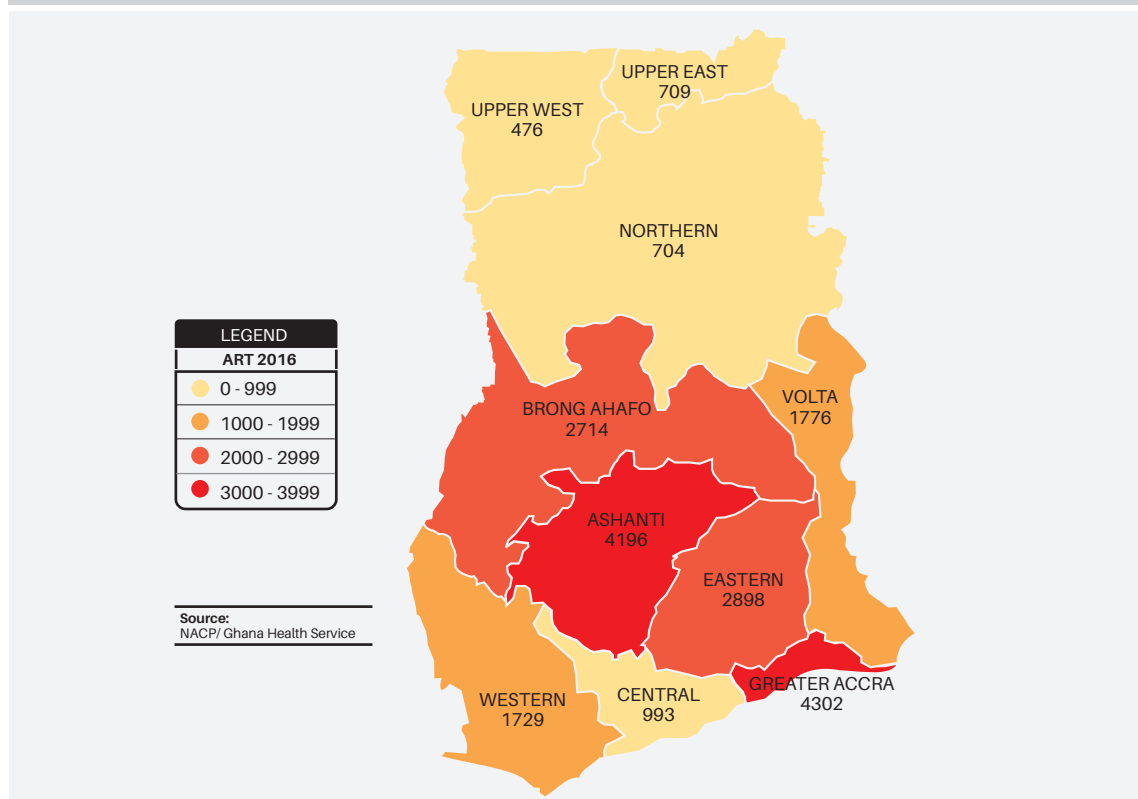

At the end of 2016, a cumulative total of 100,665 PLHIV were active and on ARV medication since 1,820 out of the cumulative 102,485 died or discontinued therapy. These are made up of 95,712 adults (73,657 females and 22,055 males) and 4,953 children made up of (2,476 girls and 2,476 boys).

3.2.1 TB and HIV Co-infection

In order to manage effectively, persons living with co-infection of TB and HIV, TB infection was monitored. Every person with HIV is screened for TB and any one with TB is also screened for HIV. In 2016, a total of 74,226 persons on ART were screened for TB, compared to 61,411 who were screened in 2015. Again, 1,247 HIV positive persons with TB were put on antiretroviral therapy in 2016 as against 1,096 in 2015.

3.2.2 HIV Drug Resistance

The National Expert Committee on HIV Drug Resistance continued to give guidance to NACP in the monitoring of HIVDR in the country. Ethical clearance has been obtained from both Noguchi and the Ghana Health Service for the commencement of the study. However the protocol for Acquired Drug Resistance (ADR) study had to be revised to include Paediatric Drug Resistance study based on WHO recommendation to merge the two surveys. The new protocol is yet to be resubmitted to the Ethical Review Committee (ERC).

LABORATORY SYSTEMS STRENGTHENING /COAG ACTIVITIES

The US Government under the Co-operative Agreement between the Ghana Health Service and the Centres for Disease Control and Prevention, Atlanta, provided funding for some activities which were implemented by the National AIDS/STI Control Programme in collaboration with the Institutional Care Division on behalf of the Ghana Health Service. 2016 marked the end year for the first 5year COAG however the main activities undertaken within 2016 included:

- **Proficiency Testing Programme (PTP)**
- **Basic Laboratory Information System (BLIS)**
- **Site Improvement Monitoring System (SIMS)**
- **Key Population Implementation Science Project (KPIS)**

4.1 Proficiency Testing Programme (PTP)

Nine PCR machines are available in three Teaching Hospitals, two zonal Public Health Laboratories and three regional Laboratories; these are strategically positioned to provide service throughout the country. In the year under review, all except the machine at Upper East Regional Hospital laboratory (Bolgatanga) were functional for a greater part of the year and they participated in two rounds of proficiency testing programme in HIV Viral Load (VL) and Early Infant Diagnosis (EID) organised by AfriQuaLabin Senegal and CDC, Atlanta. The machine in Bolgatanga was installed at the beginning of the year and enrolled to participate in the programme however this could not be achieved due to a technical problem with the machine.

Dried Tube Specimen Proficiency Testing (DTSPT) for HIV serology that was revamped and piloted in Greater Accra and Eastern region were expanded to cover, Western, Ashanti, all HSS sites and selected FHI 360 facilities. Two rounds of the programme were undertaken. Results for Rounds two and three were encouraging thus the proficiency rate among the regions increased from 74% to 85%; analysis of Round Four is currently going on.

4.2 Basic Laboratory Information System (BLIS)

The technical team visited the Upper East Regional Hospital laboratory (Bolgatanga) and Saltpond Municipal Hospital laboratory to resolve specific issues pertaining to implementation of BLIS. In addition, the team undertook supervisory visits to all BLIS sites to assess the status of BLIS implementation; a report was presented to the Laboratory Information Technical Working Group (LISTWG) at its maiden meeting for the year.

The National AIDS/STI Control Programme in collaboration with CDC adapted BLIS as a tool for data management for VL and EID to feed information into DHIMS 2 and E-tracker. An assessment was carried out at all PCR sites to determine hardware, software and training needs. The C4G Assessment Tool was used in all assessment undertaken.

4.3 Site Improvement Monitoring System (SIMS)

The Site Improvement Monitoring System (SIMS) programme was introduced as part of PEPFAR activities by SGAC. Selected HIV rapid testing sites within the Greater Accra, Eastern, Western and Ashanti regions were visited by a combined team from CDC and NACP. The SIMS assessments covered all aspects of HIV rapid testing ie: testing, documentation, training, safety, linkage to care among others. Based on the performance of sites using the SIMS assessment tools, follow-up visits were planned and undertaken. Overall, there were general improvements of sites after initial visits.

4.4 Key Population Implementation Science Project (KPIS)

Given the disproportionate burden of HIV infection among KP compared with the general population in Ghana, it is essential that HIV services are more accessible and better utilized among both FSW and MSM to reduce HIV transmission. KP may face unique barriers at each stage of the HIV continuum of care leading to suboptimal outcomes for HIV diagnosis, linkage to and retention in HIV care and treatment.

The KPIS project was undertaken to understand and address these barriers to ensure KP receive optimal care. Phase 1 of the study involved selected facilities in Greater Accra and Kumasi Metropolis; staff of two NGOs in the two regions and GHS staff of the facilities selected supported the activity. The objective of Phase 1 was to qualitatively assess client-level barriers and facilitators to HIV testing, retention in HIV care and treatment and also qualitatively and quantitatively assess service delivery barriers and facilitators to providing accessible, acceptable and sustainable services across the HIV continuum of care.

In the year under review, data collection was completed for data cleaning and data analysis commenced.

4.5 Co-Ag staff

Two major changes took place in the year; Doris Awudi replaced Angela Kangah as Project Coordinator and Mrs. Veronica Bekoe the laboratory focal point proceeded on terminal leave at end of December. Her role was taken over by Rowland Adukpo, the NACP Laboratory Programme Officer.

4.6 NACP Annual Retreat

Staff of the National AIDS/STI Control Programme (NACP) and the Centres for Disease Control and Prevention, Ghana office took part in a 5-day retreat at Coconut Grove Regency Hotel in Elmina from 29th August to 3rd September. The main objective of this retreat was to review the programme’s performance in 2015 and 2016 and to plan new activities for the rest of year. It provided the opportunity for staff orientation in the area of organizational development through discussion sessions on team building. The annual report for 2015 was also finalized during the retreat.

4.7 HIV Test Kits

In 2016 a total of 40,289 packs of first response kits were received at the central stores in addition to 10,289 existing stock as at December 2015 making a total of 50,578 packs. Out of this total, 25,495 packs of first response test kits were delivered to the Regional Medical Stores together with 555 packs of Oraquick test kits. Below is the test kits situation in 2016.

THE DELIVERY OF STRATEGIC INFORMATION ON HIV AND AIDS

5.1 Publications and Reprinting

- National Acceleration Plan For Paediatric HIV Services in Ghana 2016 - 2020.
- Health Sector HIV Strategic Framework 2016-2020 and M&E Plan 2016-2020.

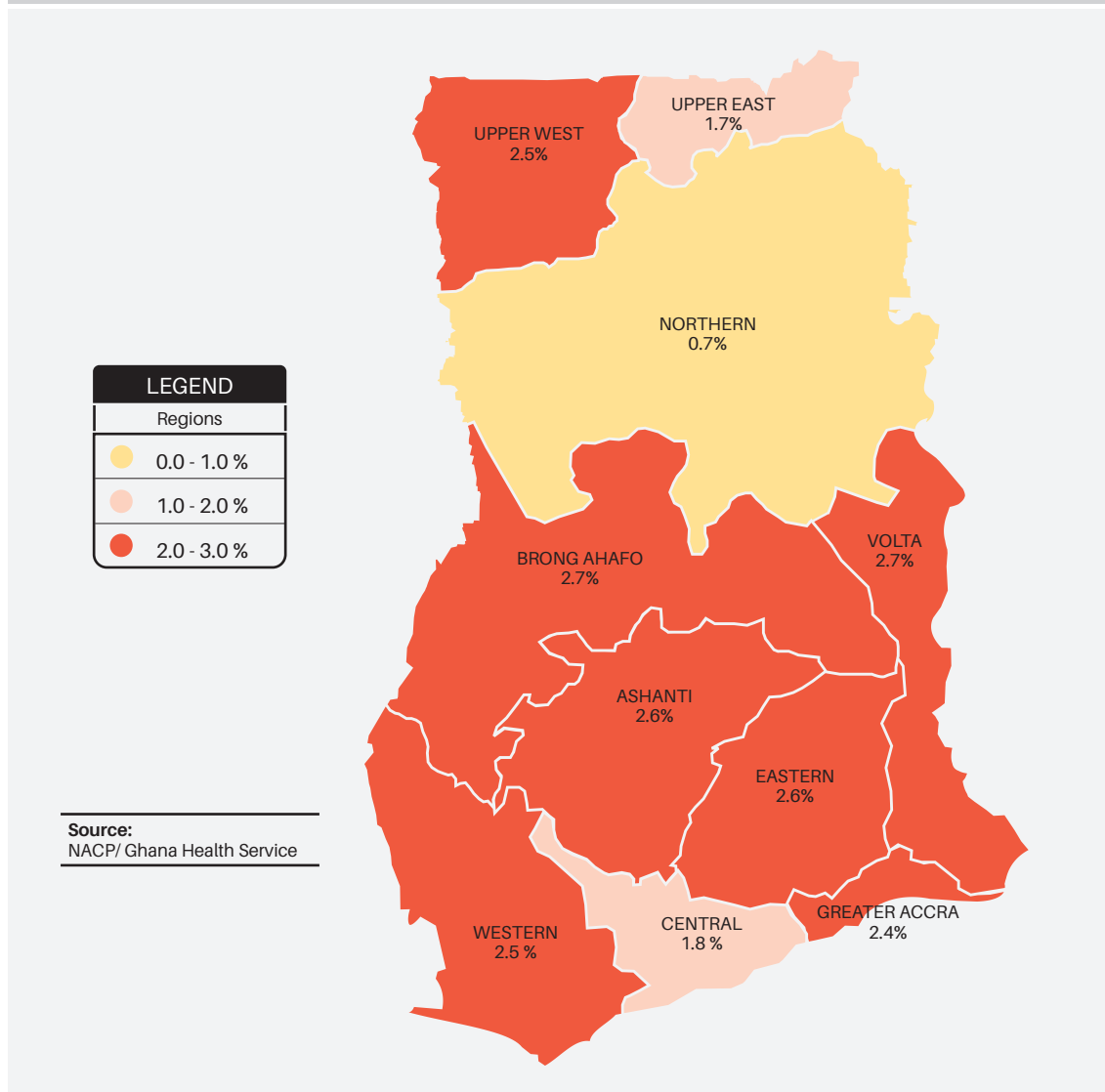
5.2 HIV Sentinel Survey

HIV Sentinel Survey remains the main tool for monitoring the trend and state of the epidemic in the country at any given time. The system is based on an annual HIV Sero Prevalence Survey conducted in Forty (40) sentinel sites using an unlinked anonymous method.

A percentage of Pregnant women accessing antenatal services for the first time and clients seeking treatment for STI during the survey period make up the sentinel population. The Survey results is the primary data for the estimation and projection of HIV infection in the general population which provides a firm basis for planning and forecasting for prevention, treatment, management and care related programmes.

The Programme successfully disseminated the results of the 2015 HSS survey. The 2016 HSS was also successfully conducted in all the 40 sentinel sites and prevalence among pregnant women was 2.4% as against 1.8% in 2015. Figure 5.1 is a map of Ghana showing the regional HIV prevalence.

5.3 Sexually Transmitted Infection Surveillance

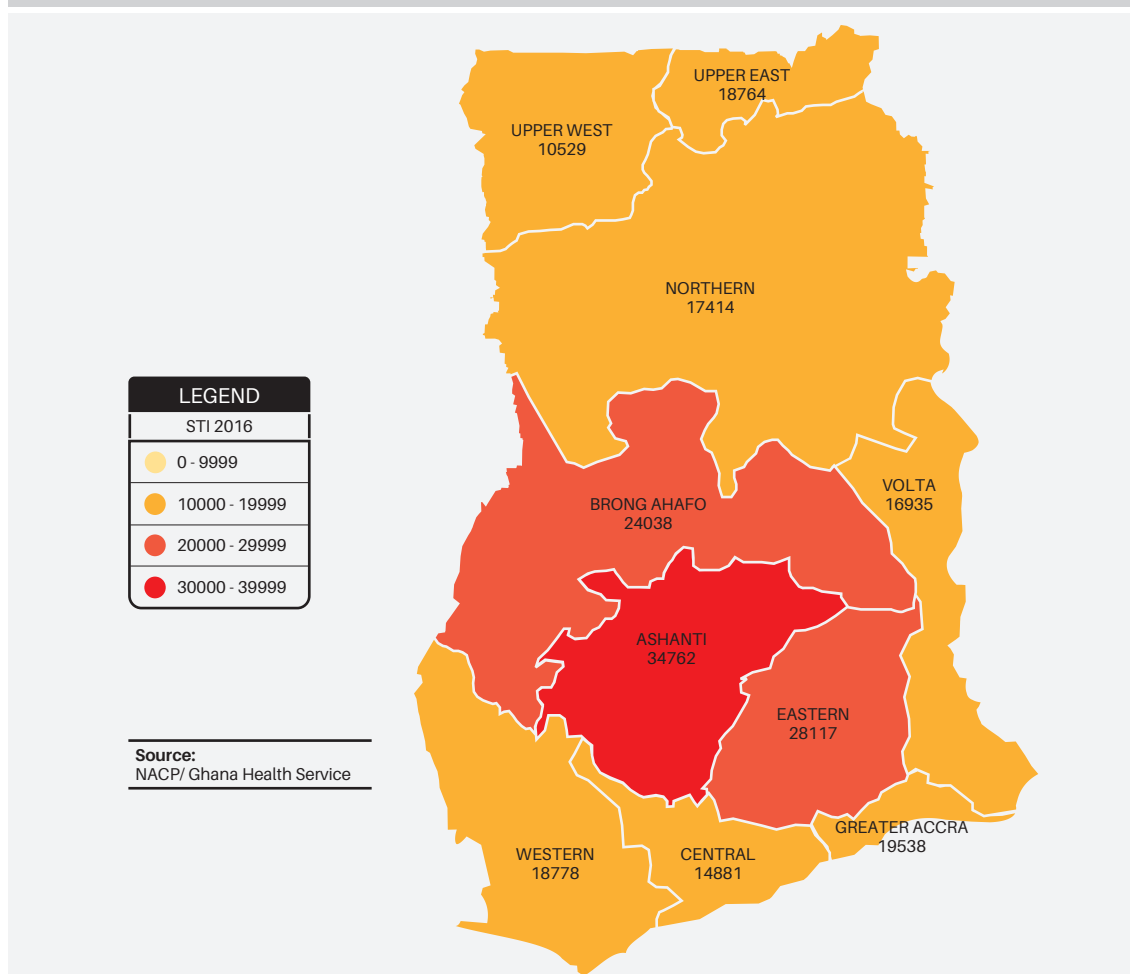
Early detection and syndromic management of Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs) is a major public health strategy for HIV prevention.

In 2016, a total of **203,756** STI cases were diagnosed and treated in the country. These were female genital ulcer, male genital ulcer, urethral discharge and vaginal discharges. The relative contributions of the various regions are shown in table 5.1.

PROVISION OF ESSENTIAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT TO ALL MDAs IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THEIR PROGRAMMES

The NACP continued to provide technical support to various MDGs, agencies and stakeholders in their workplace HIV and AIDS programmes.

The Programme participated fully in most activities of the Ghana AIDS Commission and the Country Co-ordinating Mechanism (CCM) of the Global Fund by providing technical assistance to enhance their advocacy role.

Academic institutions such as Ghana College of Physicians and Surgeons, University of Ghana School of Medicine and Dentistry, School of Nursing and School of Public Health were not left out.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

In the year under review, from January to December 2016, the Programme received a total financial support of \$24,637,099.08 from its donor partners. Most of the support was from the Global Fund with an amount of \$23,997,162.18 representing 97% of the total funds whilst other donors (CDC, APHL, WHO and the UNICEF) contributed \$639,936.90 representing 3% of total receipts.

These Funds supported the GHS/MoH in the implementation of strategic activities such as PMTCT, ART, and HIV Testing, HIV/TB Collaboration, Health Systems Strengthening, Programme Management and M&E.

The year's total expenditure was \$29,521,836.94. A summary of the breakdown showing cumulative disbursement and expenditures as at the end 2016 is shown below:

Total Expenditure within 2016

In 2016, total expenditure under the various cost categories/Cost Groupings and SDAs/ Modules by the NACP amounted to \$29,521,836.94. Expenditure under the NFM amounted to \$28,824,294.71 while expenditure under others amounted to \$697,542.23. The cost categories are as defined below.

1. **Human Resource**- includes all HR expenditure under the grants
2. **Travel Related Cost** -includes training, Supervision, surveys, data collection, meeting, advocacy related costs etc.
3. **External Professional services** - includes Data Quality Assessment, HIV Sentinel Survey, DHIMS activities etc
4. **Health Products** - Pharmaceutical Products - includes Procurement of ARVs for ART etc
5. **Health Products** - Non-Pharmaceuticals -includes Procurement of HIV Test kits, BD, Viral Load, Haematology and Chemistry reagents etc
6. **Health Products** - Equipment - includes cost of Maintaining Laboratory equipment, CD4 and Hematology Machines etc
7. **Procurement and Supply** - Chain Management costs (PSM)-includes Freight and Insurance, Warehouse and Storage, distribution etc,
8. **Non-health equipment**- includes the procurement of Computers and Accessories for ART client Data capture and monitoring
9. **Communication Material and Publications** - includes the cost of printing of tools and registers, IEC materials, reports, PMTCT and HTC manuals etc
10. **Programme Administration costs** - includes office related costs

Fig: 7.1 GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2016 TOTAL EXPENDITURE BY COST CATEGORIES

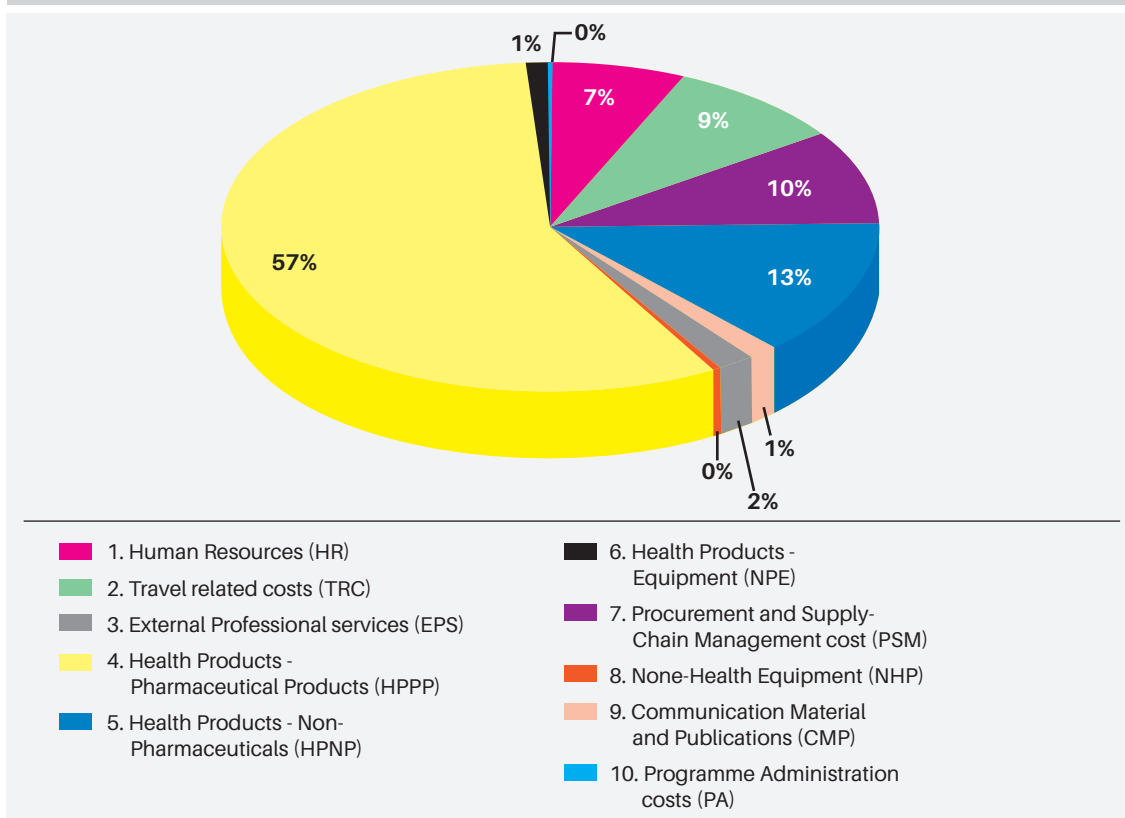
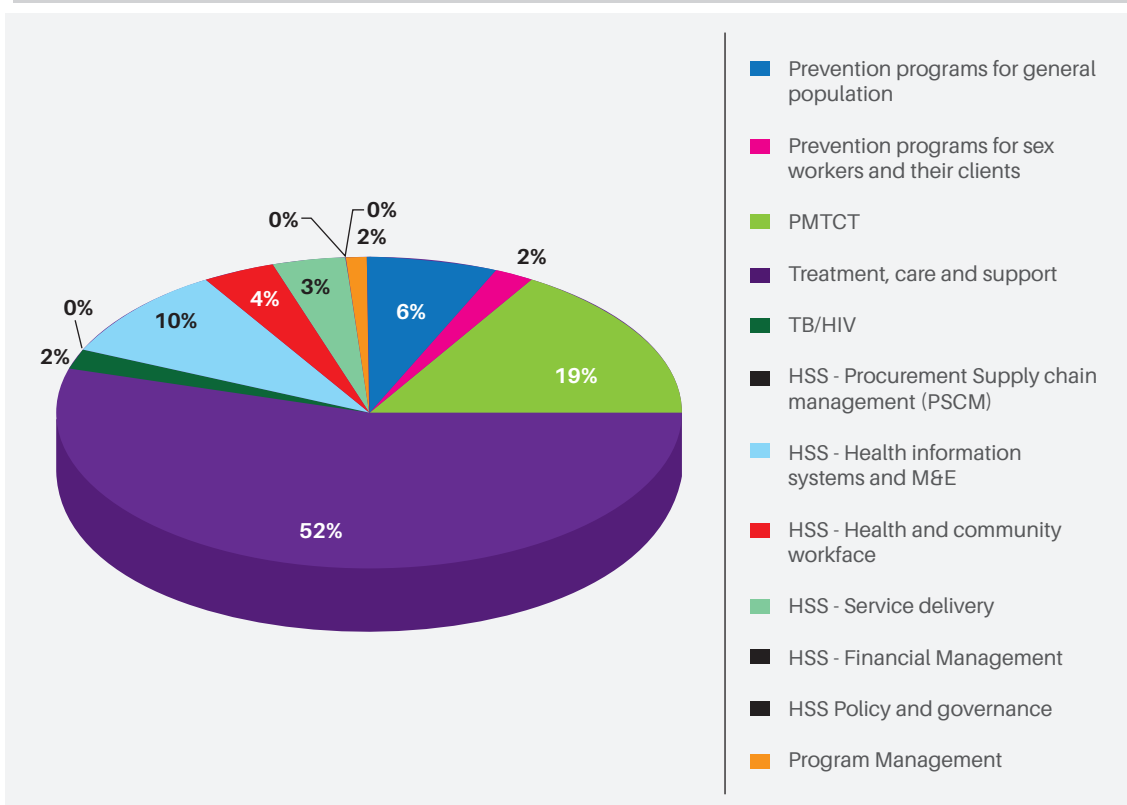

Fig: 7.2 GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF 2016 TOTAL EXPENDITURE BY MODULES

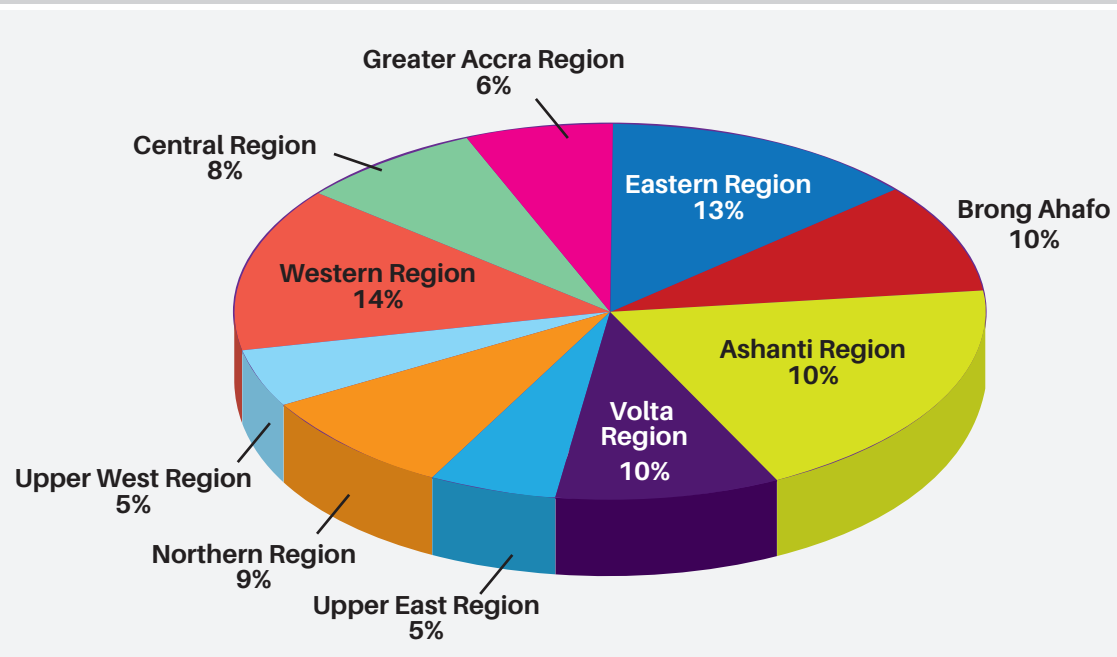
7.2 Financial Support to Regions

PEPFAR Support

The United States Government (USG) committed to provide the Ghana Programme with a total of twenty-three million, seven hundred and seventy nine thousand, five hundred and fifty four dollars (US\$23,779,554) for two years as one time support for ART and related commodities for Ghana. Funding from the USG, through the U.S President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) will enable the GoG to provide services for 57,531 clients by the end of 2018.

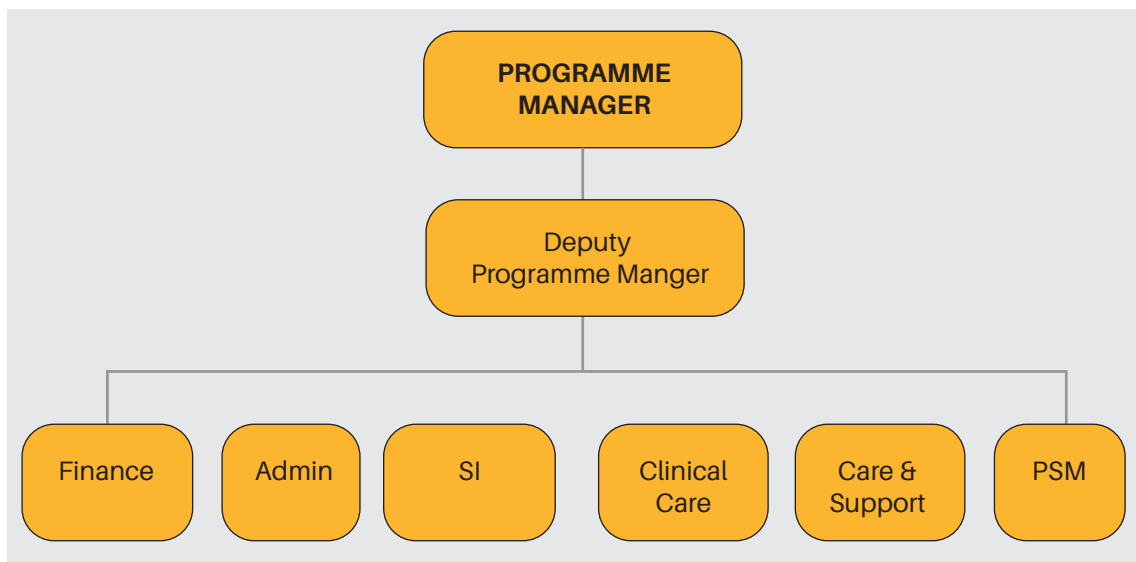
Under the agreement, the GoG will significantly scale up domestic financing for HIV treatment and assume financial responsibility for persons enrolled and currently on treatment with PEPFAR funds by 2019.

ADMINISTRATION

8.1 Human Resource

The Programme was headed by the Programme Manager, Dr. Stephen Ayisi Addo and assisted by 33 Core Staff and 147 data officers within the following units: Care & Support (3), Clinical Care (2), Laboratory & Surveillance (7), Strategic Information (4), Finance (5), and Administration and Support Services (12). The data officers are primarily assigned to ART sites throughout the country.

NACP received technical support from other partners: WHO, Procurement and Supply Directorate of the Ministry of Health (P&S/MOH), the Stores Supply and Drug Management of the Ghana Health Service (SSDM/GHS), Noguchi Memorial Institute of Medical Research (NMIMR), Regional Health Directorates, PHRL, USAID, CDC, among others in the implementation of its planned activities. The programme was also assisted by regional/ facility HIV coordinators and the ART & HIVDR Technical working group.

8.2 Programme Management

8.2.1 Staff Meetings

Four staff meetings were held in the course of the year as well as a staff retreat. In these meetings, various units provided updates of their activities and finalization of 2015 annual report as well as deliberations on the development of the Programme and the way forward. Ideas and skills were shared.

8.2.2 Technical Meetings

Three meetings of the Joint Technical Working Group on ART and HIVDR were held in the year under review.

The Programme took part in the weekly meetings of the Public Health Division, Weekly Meetings of GHS Directors, Unit Heads and the biannual meetings of the Public Health Directorate of the Ghana Health Service. It also participated in the HIV Partnership Forum, Health Summit, and the Senior Managers Meetings of the Ghana Health Service.

8.2.3 Review Meetings

NACP and NTP had a joint annual review meeting from 24th to 28th January in Koforidua, Eastern Region and a midyear review meeting from the 22nd to 24th August in Kumasi-Ashanti Region. In these meetings, stakeholders and regional teams were invited to deliberate on activities during the year, the challenges and way forward.

8.2.4 International Meetings

The following international conferences were attended by the Programme Manager and other technical staff.

1. UNAIDS Programme Coordinating Board Meetings in Geneva in June and December.
2. Expert Meetings to develop task-sharing checklist for 90/90/90 in Geneva.

MONITORING

9.1 ART and PMTCT Supportive Supervision

Monitoring forms a key part of NACP's activities in order to follow the progress of implementation of the health sector HIV and AIDS interventions. Monitoring and support visits were undertaken by national and regional officers of the Ghana Health Service. Two support visits were undertaken to the Volta Region and Upper East Regions respectively by the Programme Manager. Apart from these, a joint monitoring and support visit was undertaken with the Family Health Division and JUTA.

9.2 CoAg Monitoring Visits

Two monitoring visits were undertaken to the Western and Northern Regions by the Programme Manager of NACP, the Dep. Director General of the GHS, the US Ambassador to Ghana and the Director of Public Health, GHS. These visits were a collaboration between the Government of Ghana and the US Government in the fight against HIV. The purpose of the visits was to observe activities at the ART Clinic and U.S. Government partnership initiatives with the Ministry of Health and the Ghana Health Service (GHS) for the provision of care and support for PLHIVs. The team also took the opportunity to interact with Persons Living with HIV. They also visited the Public Health Reference Laboratories of those regions to ascertain the state of the PCR equipment and the challenges associated with Viral Load testing.

CHALLENGES

10.1 Funding gap for commodities

It emerged from the 2016 National Quantification for HIV commodities that over 17 million USD was required to bridge the funding gap in commodities for 2016 and 2017. Unavailability of funds to fill the gap consistently poses a threat to HIV commodity security. The restricted fiscal space rendered the Government of Ghana incapable of also fulfilling its counterpart financing obligations for the support of clients on Antiretroviral therapy resulting in serious conditions imposed on the country by the Global Fund. The latter significantly strained programmatic implementation within the year under review.

10.2 Weak viral load testing programme

Low viral load testing coverage - This can be attributed to lack of request from health care staff, logistical challenges in transporting samples from requesting health facilities to the regional DNA PCR labs and transmission of the test results. These were further aggravated by periodic breakdown of testing platforms.

10.3 Human Resource

Inadequate staff at national, regional and facility levels has resulted in the overburdening of limited staff, thus, affecting quality of service delivery. This is compounded by high staff turnover which has resulted in capacity gaps at facility levels. The yearly transfer of service providers both within and outside the facilities created human resource gaps which affected the delivery of services. The situation unfortunately is the same.

10.4 Limited Infrastructure

Infrastructure to ensure effective and efficient provision of HIV services was also limited. Efforts at refurbishing existing warehouses have stalled due to lack of funds. Other warehouses also have limited storage spaces. Unfortunately, there are no funds available from the New Funding Model (NFM) for infrastructural refurbishment and expansion.

10.5 Frequent breakdown of laboratory equipment

Frequent breakdown of equipment (chemistry, haematology, DNA PCR and CD4 machine) was a major challenge. This is because many of the machines are obsolete and out of service machines. Moreover no allocation was made for the maintenance of chemistry and haematology equipment. To address the challenge, a reprogramming request was made to the GF for the procurement new equipment.

10.6 Service coverage gap

Very low male testing, low PMTCT coverage rates, high MTCT levels and high loss-to-follow-up were recorded in 2016. There was also low level of Couple HIV Testing and Counselling (CHTC) especially among serodiscordant couples in the country.

WAY FORWARD

11.1 Funding the gap for commodities

The Programme will apply for new Global Fund resources for the years 2018 to 2020 and ensure existing MOUs are executed with full government support to fill the funding gap. Also, other sources of support will be explored from partners. NACP will continue to foster close and stronger collaboration with the Ghana AIDS Commission and other stakeholders in the mobilization of funds through the AIDS fund.

11.2 Strengthening viral load testing programme

A viral load scale up plan will be developed and implemented. This is expected to address challenges with sample referral, equipment maintenance, training and capacity building for testing staff, quality assurance and data management.

11.3 Filling the gaps in Human Resource

Dissemination and implementation of the task shifting policy is expected to make more staff available for HIV activities. Implementation of various Differentiated Models of Care will also improve efficiency at service delivery points.

11.4 Addressing the Frequent breakdown of laboratory equipment

The Programme will continue efforts towards the implementation of a systematic plan for equipment maintenance and replacement in collaboration with the Health Administration and Support Services Division (HASS).

11.5 Improving Service coverage

The overall performance is expected to increase especially in the area of EID and Viral load testing. Efforts to improve PMTCT through integration with greater involvement of the district public health nurses will continue.

With the expected commencement of the last mile implementation, commodity shortage at facility levels are also expected to reduce. The implementation of the revised ART guidelines will also commence in the remaining six regions (Northern, Upper East, Upper West, Central, Brong Ahafo and Volta).

The implementation of the E-tracker will help reduce the numbers of clients lost to follow-up.

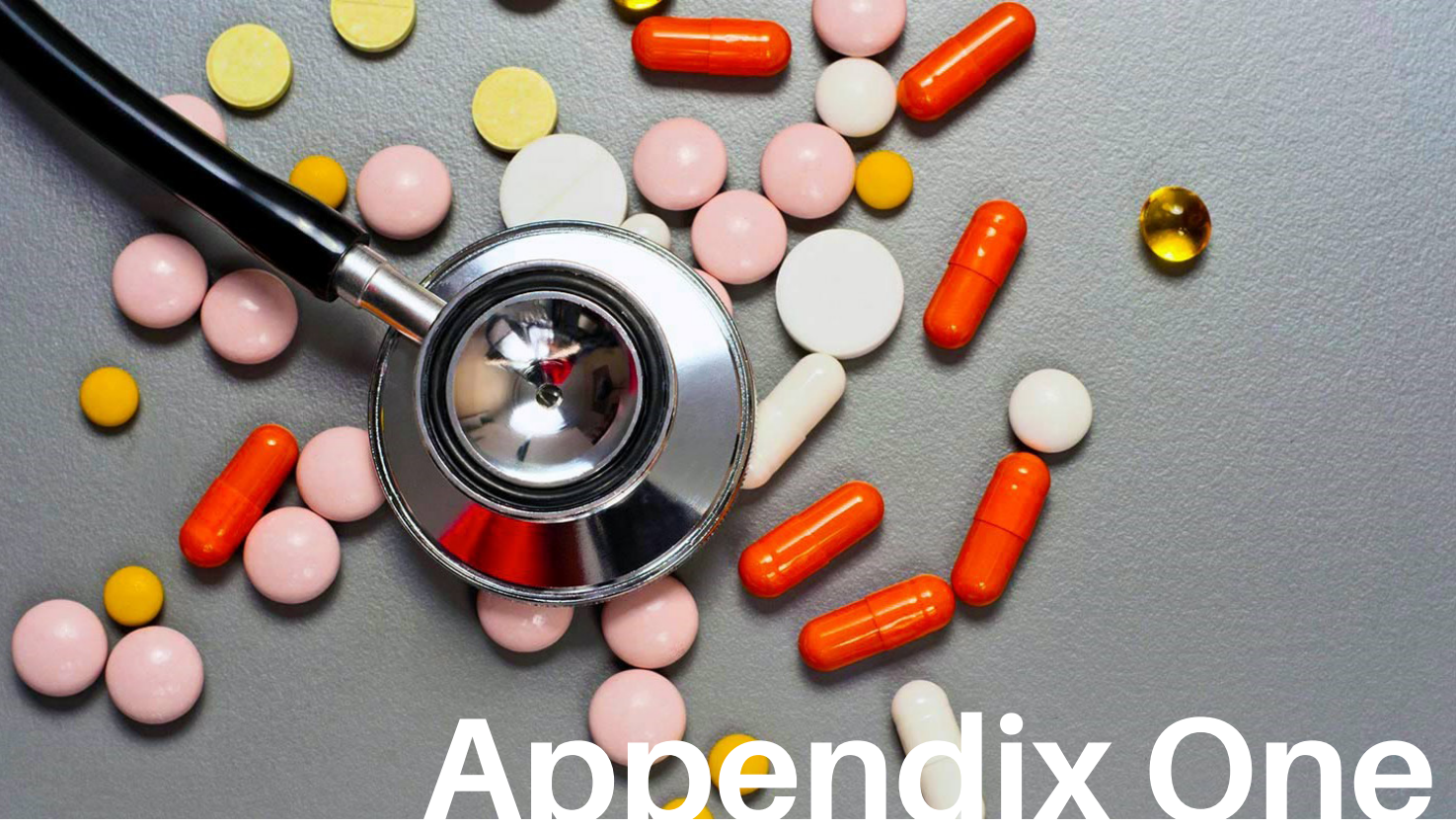
CONCLUSION

In conclusion, the year under review was characterized by mixed fortunes in Performance. Key area such as testing coverage in the general population was higher in 2016 compared to 2015. For the same period more pregnant women were tested and received results as compared to 2015. Pregnant women, attending antenatal clinics testing positive and given ARVs decreased in 2016 by 11percent as compared to 2015. There was however an increase in the number of babies screened using DNA PCR and children given ARVs.

The programme intends however to work towards reaching 90 percent of the general population in the coming year for testing and to offer 90 percent of those reactive with antiretroviral medications.

The Viral Load Scale-up plan and referral systems for specimens will be implemented to ensure an improvement in viral suppression amongst ART clients.

All these would be achieved through the Scale-up of service coverage and differentiated models of care, greater intergration of services, an improvement in data quality and strategic information generation and facilitated by stronger collaboration with partners and advocacy for increased resource mobilization to achieve epidemic control within the shortest possible time.

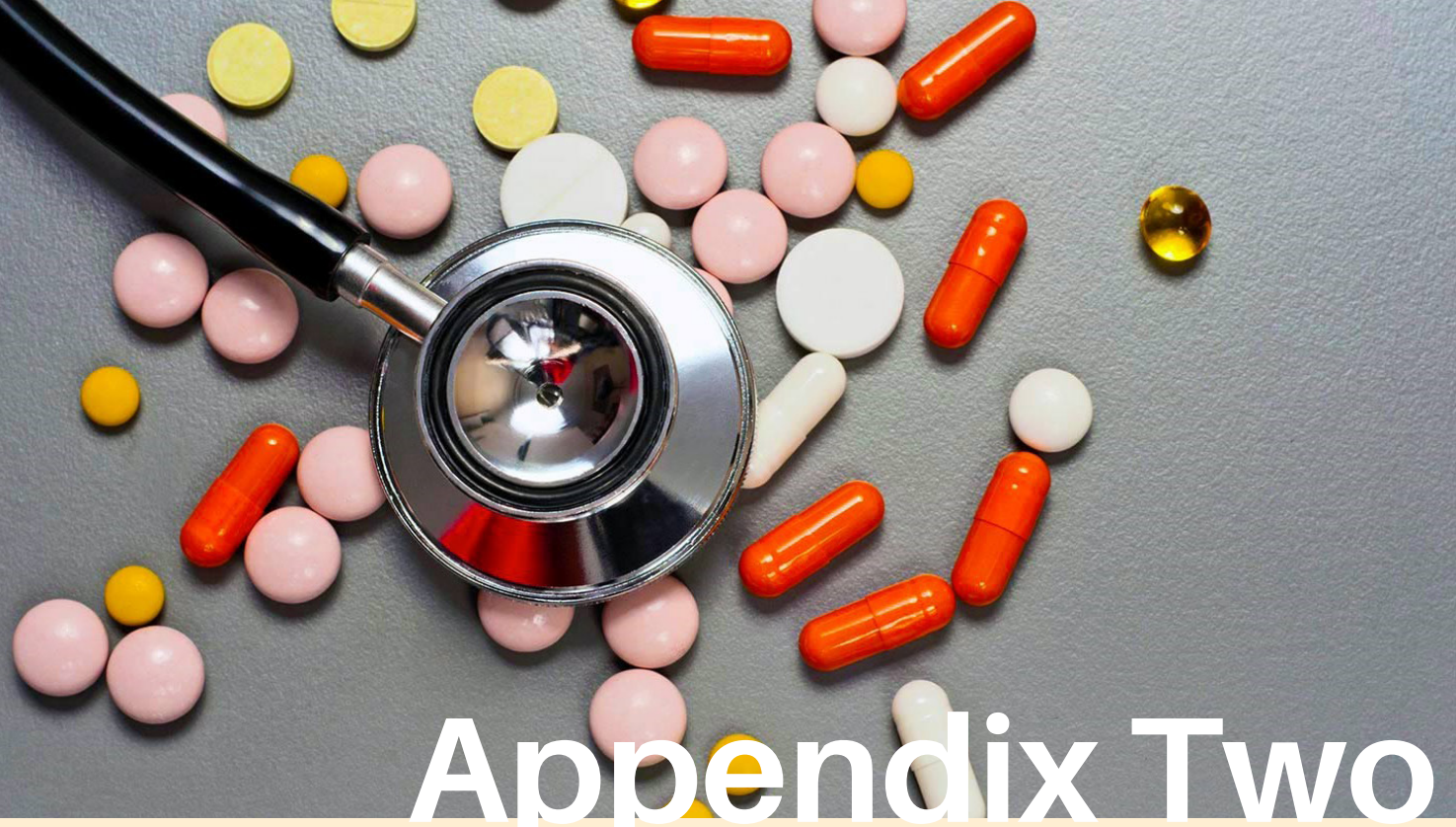

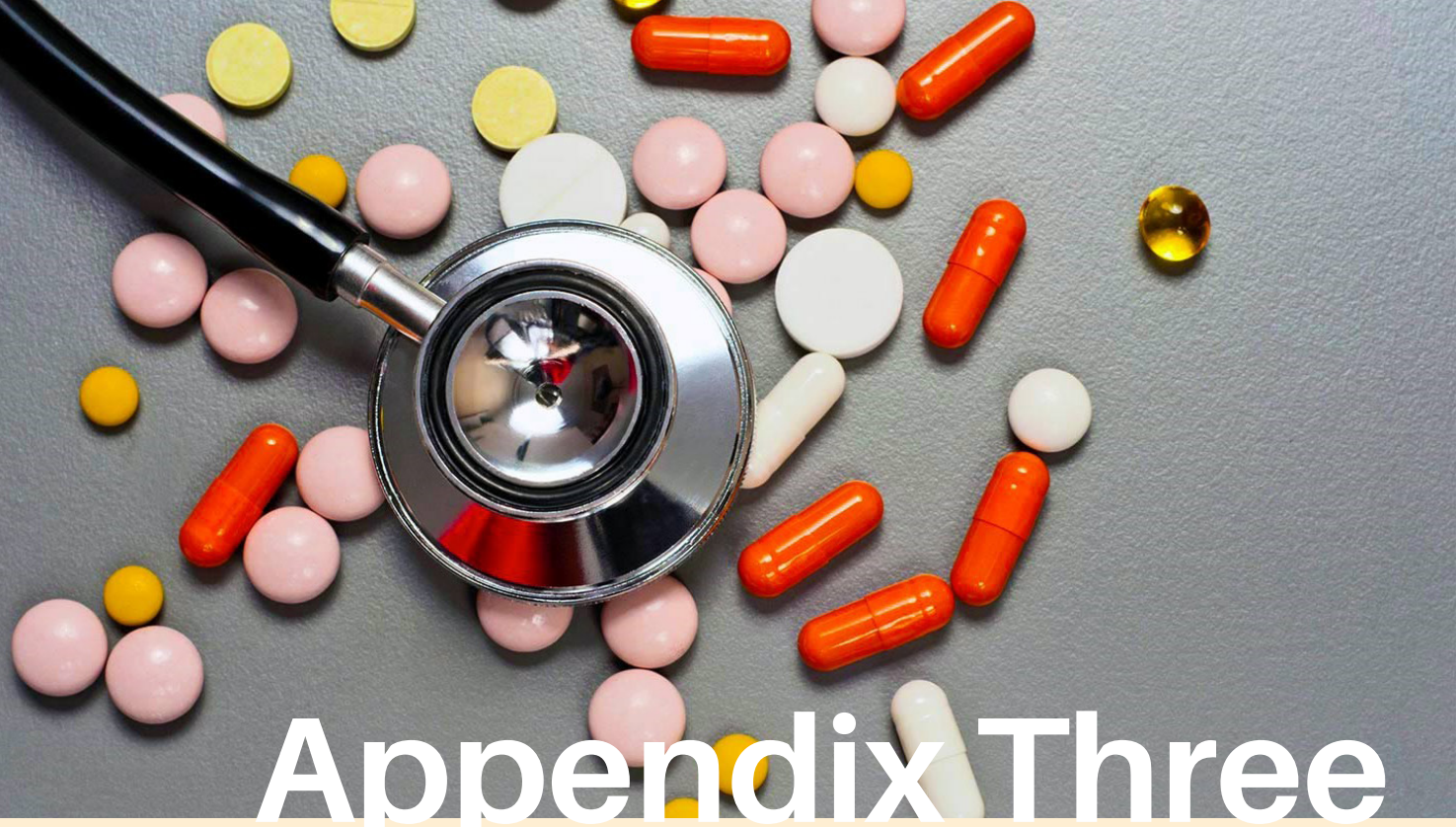

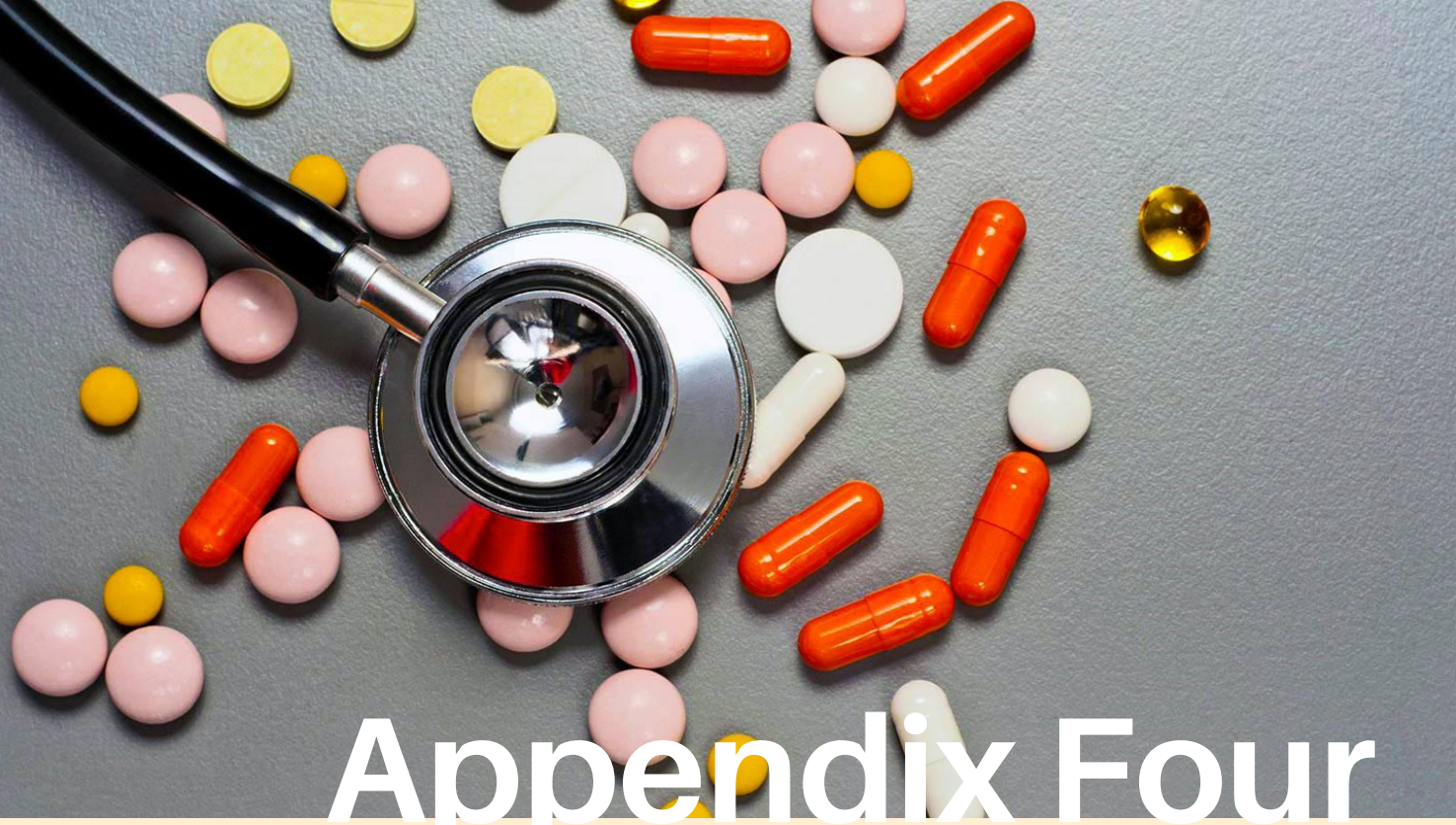
